You can bring in large quantities or large items of combustible waste directly for a fee.
Business Hours: Monday to Friday (closed on weekends, year-end and New Year holidays)
Reception Hours: 8:30 AM to 11:00 AM / 1:00 PM to 4:30 PM
Fee: ¥180 per 10 kg

Combustible Waste Place combustible waste in the designated yellow bags and place them in the combustible waste collection bins on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.

- Food waste (with moisture removed)
- Tattered clothing, clothes that cannot be reused
- Rubber and leather products
- Other items (disposable hand warmers, desiccants, medical poultices, etc.)
- Plastic products with stubborn stains, plastic packaging
- Waste cooking oil (solidified with chemicals)
- Wood items (chopsticks, dead branches, etc.)
- Paper scraps



Warning: Do not place products with built-in batteries

Recyclable Plastics Plastic products are now eligible for collection. Place them in the village-specific garbage bags on the specified day and take them to the collection site.

Plastic Products

- Items made entirely plastic
- Products made entirely or mostly of plastic
- Products must be clean
- Within 50cm length (longer items should be cut)
- Plastic kitchenware such as bowls, Tupperware-type containers, sponges, etc.
- Brushes, washbasins, laundry clips, straws, plastic dishes
- Plastic stationery such as ballpoint pens, rulers, and clear files
- Plastic container products such as planters, poly buckets, and trash cans
- CDs and DVDs (including plastic storage cases)
- Vinyl products such as raincoats and inflatable rings (cut to 50cm or less)
- ※ If there is a small amount of metal, remove it if it can be easily disassembled, and sort it before disposal.



Warning: Do not place products with built-in batteries

Packing Plastic

- Bags, wrapping films
- Trays and food containers, like convenience store meals
- Bottles other than PET bottles
- Caps, labels
- Styrofoam, packing materials (such as bubble wrap)

It's ok to put them together



PET Bottles Place them in the designated bag at the collection site on the specified day.

- Beverage containers
- Seasoning containers



- 1 Rinse the inside of the PET bottle.
 - 2 Remove the cap and label seal (put in recyclable plastics).
 - 3 Crush the bottle with your feet.
- ※ Containers for edible oil are not PET bottles (put in recyclable plastics).

Paper Containers and Packaging Place them in the designated bags at the collection site on the specified day.

- Bags, cardboard
- Cups
- Boxes
- Lids

- 1 Remove any plastic, vinyl, metal, etc.
- 2 If there is any dirt, wash and thoroughly dry it before disposal.

Bottles Take them to the specified station on the landfill waste collection date and time.

- Beverage bottles
- Food jars
- Cosmetic jars



- 1 Remove crowns, lids, caps, etc.
 - 2 Wash the bottles.
- ※ Bottles with milky white mouths, ceramic bottles, and heat-resistant glass should be disposed of as landfill waste.

Aluminum Cans Place them in the designated aluminum can bags and take them to the collection site on the specified day.

- Aluminum cans
- Aluminum containers (such as aluminum foil and aluminum cups)



- 1 Rinse the container
- 2 For aluminum containers like aluminum foil that have stains which cannot be removed, such as oil stains, dispose of them as landfill waste.

Metal Items Place them in the designated bags at the collection site on the specified day.

- Steel cans
- Pots, pans, etc.
- Knives, scissors, box cutter blades, etc.
- Spray cans
- Hanger and umbrella frames



※ Completely use up the gases in the spray cans or cassette cylinders (insecticides/hair dye / deodorant) and after emptying the contents, puncture them with a degasser, etc.

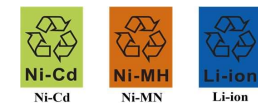
Landfill Waste Place it in the designated landfill waste bag, write your name on it, and take it to the specified station on the collection date and time.

- Glass products
- Pottery and ceramics
- Incandescent bulbs, fluorescent lamps, LED bulbs



Small Rechargeable Batteries

Nickel-cadmium batteries, nickel-metal hydride batteries, and lithium-ion batteries can be disposed of in the collection boxes provided by the Municipal Construction and Environmental Department or you can use the "Recycle Station" open every Sunday morning



These items cannot be disposed of as they are. Please remove the rechargeable battery.

※ If the rechargeable battery cannot be removed, please dispose of it as hazardous waste to prevent fires. Examples include heated tobacco products, wireless earphones, electric shavers, electric toothbrushes, handheld fans, etc.



Used Paper (Newspapers and Magazines) Tie them in a cross with a string and place them at the collection site on the specified day.



- 1 Separate newspapers into one bundle and magazines into another bundle.
- 2 Magazines includes catalogs, magazines, flyers, brochures, envelopes, wrapping paper, and paper cores from toilet paper rolls, among other paper items, excluding paper containers and packaging.

Cardboard Tie them in a cross with a string and take them to the specified station on the collection date.

- Cardboard
- 1 Bundle cardboard separately.
 - 2 Collection date and time are the same as for landfill waste and bottles.

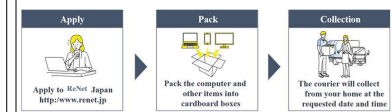
Home Appliances Bring home appliances to Nakahira Shoten Co., Ltd. (332-1 Konol) on the specified date and time. Phone: 0265-35-2011

- Home appliances **except for six items (dryers, air conditioners, washing machines, TVs, refrigerators, and freezers)**
- Please check the "Garbage Sorting Guidebook" for the items that can be put out.
- ※ Batteries and fluorescent tubes must be removed.



PCs and Small Appliance Collection by a Delivery Service (fee required)

ReNet Japan Recycle Co., Ltd. offers a home collection of small home appliances through a delivery service (fee required). If you wish to arrange a collection, please follow the instructions below.



- Items for collection: Computers, mobile phones, video, audio, kitchen appliances, household appliances, and more (over 400 items)
- Fee: 1 cardboard box: 1,760 yen (tax included)
- Size of the cardboard box: The total of three sides is within 140 cm, weight within 20 kg.
- If a computer (main body) is included, the fee for one box is **free**.
